

## Your my529 College Savings Account





Your baby's \$500 college savings account (called a CSA) is held at one of the top college savings programs in the country, called my529.

Oakland Promise is the Account Owner, the child is the Sole Beneficiary, and you are the Interested Party on the account.



Your baby will be able to withdraw this money to pay for their college or career technical education expenses after high school and before they turn 25.



You can see how your baby's college savings account (CSA) grows at my529.org! Please contact the Brilliant Baby Team any time you change your email or phone number.

## Brilliant Baby Financial Coaching Program





The Brilliant Baby Financial Coaching Program hopes to support you and help reduce financial stress on your family. After signing up for the Brilliant Baby Program, you will be assigned a financial coach!







During your first session, you will discuss your financial and life goals.



Your coach will help you create a simple plan that WORKS for you.





You can meet with your coach for up to 6 sessions.

Attend our Community Connection workshops to continue learning about financial topics as well as community resources available to your family.

Because of limited space, financial coaching will be available to you for 9 months. If you don't use that spot, we'll have to close your case.



You can earn up to \$300 in stipends for attending financial coaching sessions.





## Financial Coaching Program Stipends



Parents with a baby enrolled in the Brilliant Baby program are eligible to receive up to \$300 in Brilliant Baby Stipends. You can choose how you spend the stipend. Many families put the money towards one of their financial goals.



You can earn a \$300 stipend for attending the <u>first three</u> coaching sessions. Attend up to 6 hours of coaching. The last three coaching sessions are unpaid.




We use Zelle to pay stipends and automatically deposit money into your bank account. If you don't have Zelle, we can help you open an account or mail you a check.



## How to Sign Up for My Student's Oakland Promise Scholarship



Find your State Student Identification number (SSID).

- 1.Log into your Aeries account.
- 2.Select Student Info.
- 3.Next, select **Demographics**.
- 4.Then, select **General** and your **10- digit** SSID will be visible.

\*The SSID is a 10 digit number. It is not the same as the regular student ID number. You can also contact your student's teacher or school staff for this number.

- The baby has or is eligible for Medi-Cal.
- The baby is under the age of two years old.



### **Brilliant Baby Services**

### College Savings Account

Oakland Promise opens a \$500 college savings account in your child's name. After high school, when your child enrolls in a two or four-year college or vocational school, the account will grow in value, and these funds can be used to pay for tuition, fees, books, housing, and other qualified educational expenses.



#### 2. Financial Coaching

Parents and guardians are invited into our free financial coaching program. During your first session, you will discuss your financial and life goals. Earn stipends while actively involved in coaching during your first year with Brilliant Baby.



### 3. Community Connections Events

Join us for Community Connections meetings on Zoom. Our community partners and financial coaches share information about financial tips, early childhood development, and school readiness. We also introduce families to other community resources.



CalKIDS is a new program from the State of California that provides up to \$100 in free money for college to all babies born to a California family on or after July 1, 2022. CalKIDS can help families boost their children's college savings and increase access to higher education.

The California Kids Investment and Development Savings Program (CalKIDS) is a children's savings account program, administered by the ScholarShare Investment Board, an agency of the state of California. CalKIDS will provide children born in California with college savings accounts, including seed deposits and other potential incentives, to help pay for future qualified higher education expenses.
